- Visit Richland and obtain a referral to take the placement test to determine eligibility (if required) by **April 5, 2017**
- Complete the free Application for Federal Student Aid (if needed) to enroll in fall courses
- Summer Bridge enrollment is contingent upon class availability, so enroll as soon as possible!
- All Summer Bridge Candidates will attend our Student English Bridge Introductory Reception on **May 16, 2017 at 6 p.m.** at Richland Community College
