

Student Club/Organization Awards Information Form

The Office of Campus Life student club/organization awards were established with the express purpose of recognizing the contributions of students and their clubs/organizations to the Richland Community College campus.

General Information

1. Anyone affiliated with Richland Community College (student, faculty, administration, staff, alumni, etc.) may nominate an organization or program.
2. Only registered Richland Community College student organizations are eligible.
3. No limit is placed on the number of nominations submitted by one person, however, each nomination form must be submitted separately for each program award.
4. Nominations for all awards are due **Wednesday, April 1, 2009** to the Office of Campus Life (C131).

Awards and Criteria

Multi-Cultural Program of the Year Award is presented to the Richland Community College student club/organization whose creative and unique program or event set the standard for quality programming at Richland. The following criteria are evaluated for this award:

- Embraces the college's initiatives to enhance diversity on the college campus and community
- Student involvement in planning, implementing and reflection
- Improvement of the campus climate as it relates to race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, culture, disabilities and/or wellness.

Community Service Program of the Year Award is presented to the Richland Community College student club/organization which has made outstanding contributions to the campus community that is considered to go above the expectations of a student club/organization. The following criteria are evaluated for this award:

- Recognizes and rewards extraordinary dedication to and excellence for volunteerism in community service
- Increase and enhance volunteerism in community service and outreach.
- Demonstrate clearly personal growth and reflection for the students through volunteerism, community service
- Benefits the club/organization membership, the college and/or the community

The Innovative Program of the Year Award is presented to the Homewood student organization president (or equivalent title) who has led his or her organization effectively and efficiently, thus raising the bar for student organizations. The following points are evaluated for this award:

- Any program (i.e. social, recreational, educational, cultural, fund raising) that is original and/or unique
- Benefits the club/organization membership, the college and/or the community
- Encourages organizational participation and teamwork
- Uses effective pre-planning and facilitation
- Demonstrates successful evaluation of program for future success
